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1. ACHL Code of Conduct

We believe everyone should have equal opportunity to access good quality, affordable and sustainable housing. The continued growth and success of Aboriginal Community Housing Ltd (ACHL) requires the commitment of all employees and directors to the highest business and ethical standards.

The Code of Conduct provides us with a set of values or principles to guide us in our work. These values are: Equality, Respect, Integrity, Accountability and Teamwork.

Whilst ACHL has policies and procedures that address specific requirements and expected conduct on the part of our employees. Our efforts to conduct our business honestly and in the best interests of those we seek to serve are based on the values that form our Code of Conduct.
